

WINCHESTER MILITARY MUSEUMS

The Curators of Winchester Military Museums present their annual programme of lunch time lectures 2008/2009.

On 16 October 2008 – Mr Alan Stanistreet, an author and medal specialist will talk on “*Heroes of the Albert Medal*”. His lecture will cover the history of the Albert Medal and investigate some of its recipients.

On 13 November 2008 – Major Eric Greatorex-Bell will talk on “*South West Asia and the rise in Islamic Militancy*”. His talk will cover the insurgency in Pakistan and Afghanistan.

On 11 December 2008 – Mr Ian Bailey, Curator of the Adjutant General’s Corps Museum will talk on “*Art Deco and Schoolies - Eltham Palace and the RAEC 1945-1992*”.

On 15 January 2009 – Revd Father Andrew Lloyd MBE the Senior Chaplain 43 (Wessex) Brigade will give a talk on “*Recusants, Mavericks, Conformists? - An overview of Roman Catholic Army Chaplaincy from 1828 to the present day*”

On 19 February 2009 – Lieutenant General Sir Christopher Wallace KBE, Chairman of the Royal Green Jackets Museum will talk on “*The Royal Americans and the Conquest of Canada: 1755-60*”.

On 12 March 2009 – Major Gerald Davies, Curator The Gurkha Museum will talk on “*The Malayan Campaign 1948-60*”. His talk will cover the political and social aspects of the campaign and some of the battles fought.

All talks will be given in the Gurkha Museum, McDonald Gallery, Peninsula Barracks starting at 12.45pm and will last between 30 – 40 minutes. After the talk sandwiches and a cash bar are available. Tickets for the talk are £5.00 per person, to include a sandwich, but NOT drinks.
